The health and safety of our students, staff, and community is our top priority while providing the highest education to our students.

## ■ Protocols for All Students ■



When a student arrives at school, the student's temperature will be taken before the student exits the car or enters any school building.

■ If their temperature is higher than 99.5 the student will be asked to stay home.



■ If their temperature is lower than 99.5 then the student will enter the building and is required to exit the car with a face mask. Students **MUST** wear their face mask for the duration of the school day. BHS will provide two masks for each student.

■ When entering the building, students will report to his/her classroom or 1st period and will be served breakfast in the classroom.



■ Hand sanitizing stations will be placed in all classrooms, entrances, hallways, and bathrooms.



The school will have selected times for students to use the bathroom, and are expected to walk in certain directions for entering and exiting the building. Students are required to maintain social distance by at least six feet.



Each teacher will wear appropriate face shields and teacher's desk will also be equipped with desk shields to assure they are protecting the students and themselves. Teachers will also be rotating classrooms, instead of students transitioning.



Each campus will be routinely cleaned throughout the school day and will extensively sanitized daily once all students are dismissed.
